Q: What is the full form of NTT?

A: NTT stands for diploma in Nursery Teacher Training.

Q: What qualifications are needed for a nursery teacher?

A: The minimum eligibility for admission to the NTT training diploma course for one year includes a minimum of 50 percent marks in their 10+2 board exams from any recognized institute in any subject.

Q: What is the yearly cost of nursery teacher training (NTT) courses?

A: The NTT training fees is Rs 9,000 for a year.

Q: What is the necessity of nursery teacher training (NTT)?

A: Candidates with NTT are able to create a positive learning atmosphere in the classroom which is very important for children to learn better and also to develop their cognitive and social skills.

Q: Can I get a government job after NTT?

A: In order to get a government job one must have other relevant qualifications and experiences along with an NTT degree. Also, candidates may need to pass the competitive exams to get government jobs.

A: After achieving the NTT degree, aspiring teachers can get into the profession of nursery/preschool teaching in government or private schools.
